## ROLE OF THE PRESIDENT

The President is the main representative for students at B&FC and is responsible for the direction and leadership of the Students' Union. As President you will be expected to:

- Lead an Exec Team meeting at least once every four college weeks and ensure agendas, minutes and action points are produced for these meetings and posted to Moodle
- Ensure Exec members (VPs) attend meetings and are held accountable for their agreed targets
- Together with the Sabbatical Officer and Student Enhancement Co-ordinator, ensure the Students' Union Exec funding is spent appropriately
- Ensure you publicise who you are, how you can be contacted, and when you will be available in the Students' Union office across all college media
- Use student representatives to gather student opinion on whatever issues arise
- React to what students tell you they want from your time in office (campaigns, trips etc.)
- Attend college committees relevant to your position
- Chair the Big Student Meetings on behalf of the Students' Union and respond to any actions raised
- Meet with the Director for Students (FE President) or Director of Higher Education (HE President) at least once a term
- Link with the NUS' Regional Development Officer to ensure the Students' Union is involved in regional and national events
