ROLE OF THE SABBATTICAL OFFICER

The SU Sabbatical Officer is the chief representative of students of Blackpool and The Fylde College and participates in relevant cross college groups that deal with all aspects of the College's work:

- To work directly with the students of Blackpool and The Fylde College on the issues, events and campaigns raised by students across all of the college sites.
- To ensure student representatives are equipped to participate appropriately in all engagement activities and model outstanding partnership working.
- To fully implement the SU's constitution, including relevant updating, to ensure that student interests are effectively represented.
- To engage in 1-to-1 negotiation and relationship management between staff and students as appropriate.
- To be the main student contact person for the National Union of Students (NUS), including attending relevant events and conferences.
- To represent students of the College through participation in a number of committees and associated task groups, including being the Chair of student forums.
- To organise and maintain a high level of student engagement via the SU's social media platforms and the engagement of partners and curriculum colleagues to promote college initiatives.
- To attend and speak at official events and ceremonies where required, at local and national level.
- To develop appropriate growth business strategies to meet SU self-sustaining objectives.
- To drive engagement in the National Student Survey.
