## ROLE OF THE VICE PRESIDENT

The Vice Presidents are the main representatives for the students in their curriculum area. If you are elected as a Vice President you will be expected to:

- Involve student representatives from your curriculum area, including yourself, in Students' Union activities (events, campaigns, volunteering, trips, surveys etc.)
- Maintain a Students' Union notice board in your curriculum area and update it regularly
- Ensure you publicise who you are and how you can be contacted across all college media and make yourself available to students in your curriculum area
- Learn about the skill-sets of students in your curriculum area (website building, photography, graphic design etc.) and access these on behalf of the Students' Union
- Attend your curriculum area's Quality Assurance Meetings (QAMs) and feedback any items raised to the Students' Union Executives Committee
- Attend all Students' Union Executive Committee meetings and carry out any actions assigned to you
- Attend all Big Student Meetings and be the spokesperson for your curriculum area
